#### **Our roots**

Even as Global has grown into Canada's largest manufacturer of furniture for workplace, education and healthcare, the company remains connected to caring for their employees, customers and for the planet. Manufacturing our products and owning most of our supply chain means we generate fewer emissions through reduced logistics and transportation needs between manufacturing facilities and our local customers.

Global has led the industry through our creative recycling efforts, the development of unique technologies for upcycling our own waste, and by continuously raising our standards for our supply chain and manufacturing facilities. In 1993, we established our own recycling facility (RT Technologies), which employs a propriety technology to combine wood and plastic waste from its own and other facilities into a new composite material.

#### **Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital (CVH)**


