

We are continuously working to minimize, reduce and eliminate chemicals of concern from both the manufacturing process and our final products. As a result, customers can purchase products that meet the ANSI/BIFMA e3-2019 Furniture Sustainability Standard, credit 7.4.4.

"Targeted Chemical Elimination" outlined below.

### Flame retardants:

Upholstered seating meets the requirements of TB 117-2013 and are labeled accordingly.

# Per and poly-fluorinated compounds:

Products do not contain long-chain, short-chain, per - and poly-fluorinated alkyl compounds or fluorinated polymers used for stain, oil, or water repellant treatment at or above 100 ppm.

### **Antimicrobials:**

Products do not contain any added or built-in chemical antimicrobials except when added to materials or products for the sole purpose of preserving the product. Triclosan and triclocarban are explicitly prohibited for any use.

# Polyvinyl chloride (PVC):

Product contains less than 1% of polyvinyl chloride (PVC) by weight, excluding electrical components.

#### Formaldehyde and other VOCs:

Products meet the requirements of ANSI/BIFMA M7.1 - through Greenguard Certification.

**Exceptions:** Product will be non-compliant if the customer specifies an upholstery that contains PVC vinyl (greater than 1% of the total product weight) or is not PFAS Free. Specification of wood arm caps/legs, or laminate tabletop/tablet arm (with PVC edging) may also produce a non-compliant option. Global has identified products and textiles that are PFAS free to help customers make informed decisions.
