


A. Turn the chair on its side and unscrew the four legs (1).




B. Using a flat head screwdriver pry C. Using a Philips screwdriver, out staples and remove the black lining to reveal chair framework




unscrew the four wood screws to detach the Upholstered Seat Cushion. (2)




D. Using a Philips screwdriver, unscrew the eight screws and washers to detach the Arms (4) from the seat/back frame Use a snub nose Philips screwdriver to unscrew the four screws and washers indicated by white arrows



E. Using a Philips screwdriver, unscrew the four screws with washers, to detach the back assembly from the Seat frame (3)





F. Strip off the fabric from the Back frame. Using a Philips screw driver, unscrew the four screws and washers to detach the Back cushion from the Back frame.

STRIP OFF FABRIC FROM ALL THE DISASSEMBLED PARTS. STRIP OFF THE FOAM FROM THE PLYWOOD PARTS USING A UTILITY KNIFE.
